



## *Keystone Porsche Parade 2009*

*From the Spectacular Mountains of Colorado -*

*Welcome to Porsche Country and the 54<sup>th</sup> Annual Porsche Parade!*

The regions of Alpine Mountain and Rocky Mountain Region, along with Zone 9, look forward to seeing you June 29<sup>th</sup> - July 4<sup>th</sup>, for our sixth Colorado Porsche Parade, this time in Keystone Colorado.

We look forward to seeing old friends and making new friends as we know many of you first time Parade goers will be coming out to stay with us. We have a great team assembled to guide you through the Parade days and the many events planned.

### ***Parade Information***

First Day Registration will be March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup>. That is correct! Three actual First Days to Register for Parade 2009. All registrations received during this period will be treated identically. The past years' rush to register on the first day will not be necessary. We ask that you take your time, no rush, and select one of the three days to register.

### **Registration**

The 54<sup>th</sup> Porsche Parade fee is \$165.00, and covers basic admittance to the Parade for the entrant, a co-entrant, and one car.

New this year, there is an additional fee per entrant and co-entrant for the four major competitive events: Concours - \$20 per car, Autocross - \$20 per driver, TSD Rally - \$10 per car, and Tech Quiz - \$10 per person.

Additional fees will apply for banquet/meal tickets and for selected other activities such as the golf tournament and the spectacular driving tours.

The co-entrant may be an unaffiliated PCA member, but must share the same car with an entrant. Each entry may register one car for the four competitive events. The only exception to the one car rule is - if the registered Porsche is not legal for street use, a second Porsche may be registered for use in the rally ONLY.

**There are two ways to register for the Colorado Parade and all its activities:**

- Before you can do that, you must have an account with the PCA website. **PLEASE BE SURE THAT YOU CHECK AHEAD OF TIME BEFORE PARADE THAT YOU CAN LOG IN.** If you don't already have an account, please do that now so you are ready to go at Registration time. If you have an account, please make sure all of your information is up to date.
- If you are not comfortable using the online method of registering, please go to the Colorado Parade site directly at [www.pca.org](http://www.pca.org) to download the registration form. Fill it in and mail it on or after March 3, 2009.
  - You can complete this registration packet and mail it with your payment to the address below. It must be **postmarked no earlier than March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009.**

As usual, there is NO early registration. The online registration site will be available beginning Tuesday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009. All online registrations submitted on March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> will be treated equally with paper registrations postmarked the same day. Forms postmarked earlier will be rejected. Please retain a copy of your registration for your records, regardless of which registration method you choose.

**DEADLINES:**

**Registration** No sooner than March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009 at 9 am Eastern and no later than June 15<sup>th</sup>. No Exceptions.

**Cancellations** Prior to June 15<sup>th</sup>, 50% of your registration fee and full banquet tickets/event fees will be refunded. Notify Keystone Parade Registrar Kathleen Lennon [kklennon@comcast.net](mailto:kklennon@comcast.net), 719/487-2842 (note this number is on Mountain time).

**No Refunds** Cancellations received after June 15<sup>th</sup> will not be refunded.

Payment (US funds) can be made by check, money order, or by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, or American Express). Checks or money orders should be payable to Parade 2009. All fees paid will be recorded and deposited at time of registration. All returned checks or rejected credit cards will automatically result in the cancellation of your registration, with no exceptions.

Each entrant, co-entrant, and all registered family-related entrants must go through the check-in process at the Keystone Conference Center on Monday, June 29<sup>th</sup>. Everyone entering Keystone Parade must be a current PCA member and if they plan to drive at the Parade, must have a valid driver's license. Be prepared to show your driver's license when you arrive. If you have registered for any of the "Big 4" competitive events (Concours, Tech Quiz, Autocross or TSD Rally) there are deadlines for entrant classification you must meet in order to compete.
